Notice to students

These exams are important. They are not only an opportunity to show us what you have learned this year, but are an important practice for exams later on in your school life.

On the day when you have an exam, **DO NOT GO TO REGISTRATION**. Instead, when the bell goes at 8.55am, line up on your form line on the Junior Yard. You will then file in to the school hall **IN SILENCE** and sit on the desk with your name on, placing your bag under the desk. For the whole time you are in the school hall, you must be silent. After break and lunch, follow the same routine and line up on your form line.

Other notes about the exams

1. **Revise carefully.** Your teachers will give you a list of the topics you need to revise, but a good starting point is to read through your exercise books, make notes on the main topics and test yourself. Many pupils find it useful to write down key facts and words on Stickynotes, which you can place around your bedroom. Ask your teacher if there is any work on ShowMyHomework which can help you.
2. **The exams will be marked out of 100.** You will receive a Results Sheet before the end of this term, which will show not only your percentage mark for each exam, but the average mark achieved by students in your year. These percentage marks do not directly affect the level your teacher will give you for your work this half term.
3. **All exams will be for one hour.**
