

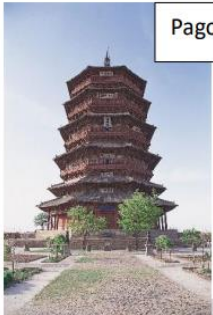
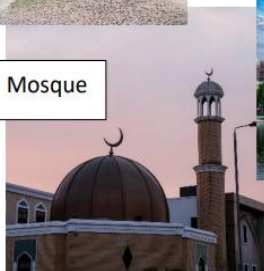


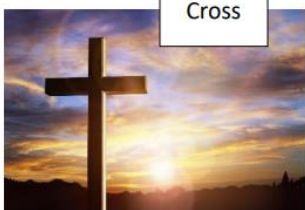
Religion, Values & Ethics Transition Work
